

The Lobster Pot

This jig originally appeared in the Stanford/Petrie collection (1905) without repeats (like many of the tunes which they notated). I've been playing it for a while now and I've added repeats in my version of the tab as well as "pick-up" notes which don't appear in the original sheet music...
